

Estimated loss in **international tourism receipts** of USD 1.1 trillion

A lifeline for SIDS, LDCs and many African countries



# UNCTAD REPORT ON THE ECONOMIC CONSEQUENCE: COVID-19 AND TOURISM

- the report quantifies the potential economic effects of the contraction in tourism in 2021
- a drop in tourist sales leads to a 2.5fold loss in real GDP, on average, in
  the absence of any stimulus measures
- the economic losses could range between \$1.7 trillion and \$2.4 trillion in 2021




### HAS YOUR COUNTRY **EXPERIENCED A REBOUND**IN INTERNATIONAL TOURISM DURING 2021?







# THE GLASGOW DECLARATION ON CLIMATE ACTION IN TOURISM

- an urgent global call for commitment to a decade of climate action in tourism
- cut global tourism emissions by at least a half over the next decade and reach Net Zero emissions as soon as possible before 2050
- each signatory will commit to deliver a concrete climate action plan, or updated plan, within 12 months of signing




### **Standards**

### **Data**

Inbound visitors, expenditure, tourism industries, employment and their sources

#### **TOURISM SATELLITE ACCOUNT**

compilation of TSA tables, domestic/inbound/outbound tourism, building basic statistics needs






## BEST TOURISM VILLAGES BY UNWTO


